**Position Description: Camp Counselor
Weaverville Summer Day Camp**

Trinity County Resource Conservation District (RCD) is accepting applications for temporary Summer Day Camp Counselors. A Camp Counselor works under the supervision of the Weaverville Summer Day Camp Coordinator. The Camp Counselor has the responsibility to supervise children, organize activities and assure the camp environment is safe and fun. Hours will be Monday through Friday, 25-30 hours per week, usually between 8 am and 3:30 pm. **Day Camp runs three weeks between July 10 – 28, 2017. Counselors must also complete four days of paid mandatory training, set for June 26 – 29, 2017.** This is a part-time position without paid leave or medical benefits. This position requires working and collaborating as part of a team.

Camp Counselors Qualifications:

1. Be an enrolled high school student or have just graduated in 2016, or be enrolled at Shasta College.
2. Experience working with children (i.e. baby sitting, church, family, etc.).
3. Enjoy working with children and be able to interact positively with children with differing abilities, backgrounds and cultural influences.
4. Ability and desire to work independently, be self-motivated and reliable.
5. Ability and desire to have fun and engage youth in a variety of activities.
6. Ability and commitment to plan, develop and lead age-appropriate activities.
7. Ability and commitment to maintain enthusiasm and engage children in a variety of activities.

Duties:

1. Attend mandatory trainings and planning sessions before camp.
2. Be a positive role model for the campers.
3. Supervise children, assuring a safe and wholesome camp environment.
4. Prepare and lead daily camp activities.
5. Communicate problems or concerns to the Camp Coordinator in a timely manner.
6. Help develop activities for camp.
7. Do necessary clean-up and camp maintenance daily.
8. Other duties as assigned.

To Apply: Complete application and return it to the Trinity High School Career Center, Trinity County RCD, Shasta College Weaverville Campus, or S.M.A.R.T. Weaverville Office.

Closing Date: May 17, 2017

Salary: starting \$10.50 per hour.
